GRAPEVINE, Texas - Grapevine Police are investigating a 16-year-old student accused of threatening to "shoot up the school".

This morning students reported that a 16-year-old Colleyville-Heritage High School student made the threat while on a shuttle en route to Grapevine High School.

Witnesses immediately reported the incident to Grapevine Police, and a School Resource Officer took the 16-year-old into custody for Terroristic Threat. The student did not have any weapons, and is no longer on campus. The student has since been released to a parent.

Grapevine Police applaud the students who reported this threat. Parents are urged to have conversations with their children and teenagers about the seriousness of making a school threat, and the importance of contacting police when they hear a threat. All citizens are reminded: "If you see something, say something."
